13. Installation

- 1. Wall-mount indoors on a suitably solid wall using fixings that are appropriate to the construction of your wall (e.g. mirror plates). Choose an appropriate location for this product bearing in mind the following:
- One wall socket is required (product needs to be plugged in and cable comes out at one corner)
- The mat can be installed any way up (there is no set top or bottom)
- Users need to be able to access the coloured 'buttons' install at a suitable height
- This product requires, but does not include, ROMPA® wirelessly- controllable products, such as bubble tubes, deluxe wall panels and/or lighting

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

When pressure is applied to a 'button' the corresponding colour will be activated on the receiving ROMPA® product(s). Pressure is required – the colour choice cannot be activated by a light touch nor by proximity alone. For best results, press the centre of the 'button'.

The selected colour will remain activated in the receiving ROMPA® product until a new colour is selected. Should another 'button' not be pressed, after one minute, the colour of the ROMPA® product will revert to its automatic cycle – the light will scroll through a sequence of colours. In other words, the 'buttons' have a latched operation – the colour stays on for one minute unless another 'button' is activated.

14. Care and Maintenance

Fabric Care

- Always supervise the use of the product.
- Organise a regular cleaning schedule.
- Vinyl will crack, tear and rub off if subjected to sharp objects or continual rubbing by hard objects. Remove shoes, and avoid buckles, zips or sharp/hard/pointed objects coming into contact with the surface.
- Check seams regularly to ensure that these are not worn or split and the interior filling cannot be accessed.
- Wipe off accidental marks/liquids at the time they occur or are noticed.
- Avoid eating and drinking whilst using these products.
- Do not place near sources of heat or fire that may damage the surface (radiators, fires, underfloor heating, hot central heating pipes etc.)
- Direct contact with bright sunlight may affect material over time.
- Do not saturate the material with lots of water.
- Some of our products contain zips for manufacturing purposes only. Do not attempt to open these or to access the interior part of these products. Never allow children or vulnerable people to access the interior part of this product.

PVC (Vinyl)

- Use a soft brush remove all loose dust/dirt. Clean with a mild detergent (such as Lux soap flakes in luke-warm solution) applied to a sponge or damp cloth.
- This may be sanitised using a weak solution of Milton fluid.
- Do not use excessive amounts of water and always ensure the PVC is dry after cleaning.
- Do not use an abrasive cleaning pad.
- Do not use boiling/very hot water, washing up liquid / aggressive detergent or solvent based cleaner as this will cause the coating to discolour and go hard. Steam cleaning is not advised.

15. Troubleshooting

In the unlikely event of product failure, check:

- Is the product plugged in?
- Are the receiving ROMPA® products plugged in and switched?
 Please note: This mat will only be compatible with ROMPA® Wi Fi products it will not operate products from suppliers other than ROMPA®
- Is the power lead still connected to the power supply? The power supply does not have a green light to indicate it is working.
- Are all the air pipes still attached to the back of the switch pads (at the back of the mat)? If not, reconnect any detached pipes
- Check the 3A fuse in the plug
