### **How To Play**

Instructions are included in the product (a booklet 21 x 15cm). These instructions have a Copyright symbol on them so they are not reproduced here.

## Safety

This game is intended for all ages, but we recommend that it is only used by players over three years of age as this game contains some small parts. The die is  $1.5 \,\mathrm{cm}^3$ . The 4 counters are each  $2.5 \,\mathrm{x} \, 1.3 \,\mathrm{cm}$  diameter. The 40 blue disc counters are  $2.4 \,\mathrm{cm}$  diameter x  $0.1 \,\mathrm{cm}$ . Never place any of the pieces in the mouth.

The use of this game must always be supervised by competent adults.

When not in use, store in a safe place, out of reach of clients.

The sand timer is glass, but is enclosed in a transparent plastic tube.

#### **Care and Maintenance**

When not in use, store in a clean, dry and safe place, out of reach of clients. Handle the game with care.

Do not strike or drop the sand timer.

Keep the parts in the box to avoid losing any parts.
