## EN 71-1:2014 Mechanical and physical

**4.1 Material cleanliness** **PASS**

The toy and its materials were visually clean and free from infestation.

**4.5 Glass** **PASS**

The glass within the sand timer was inaccessible.

**4.7 Edges** **PASS**

No accessible sharp edges or hazardous burrs were found.

**4.8 Points and metallic wires** **PASS**

No technically accessible wires or sharp points were found.

**6 Packaging** **PASS**

Packaging is defined as material accompanying a toy with no intended play function.

The packaging requirement does not apply to the box shrink-wrap as it is in the form of "shrunk-on film packaging, which is normally destroyed when the packaging is opened by the user".

The packaging was not in the form of plastic bags, plastic sheeting, small balls, rounded cylinders or hemispheres.

**7.1 Labelling - General** **PASS**

The warning present was not misleading or incorrect in its wording.

There was no conflict between the warning and the intended use of the toy.

The warning was preceded by "Warning".

The warning was visible, easily legible, understandable and accurate.

The warning was on the packaging.

The warning was visible at the time of purchase.


The blocks were small parts.


**EN 71-2:2011+A1:2014 Flammability****4.1 General requirements****PASS**




**EN 71-3:2013+A1:2014 Migration of certain elements****No analysis required****PASS**

Due to the toy being intended for older children and with no parts intended for prolonged skin contact or to be put in, or to the mouth it was considered that the toy excluded any risk due to sucking, licking, swallowing or prolonged skin contact when they toy is used in a foreseeable way, bearing in mind the behaviour of children. Therefore there were no requirements applicable to the toy.
